



WAIKIKI AQUARIUM TO IMPLEMENT SAFE ACCESS OAHU REQUIREMENTS ON SEPTEMBER 13

In accordance with the Safe Access Oahu mandate, the Waikiki Aquarium will require that all staff and guests ages 12 and older provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination prior to entry, effective Monday, September 13, 2021. Identification matching vaccination proof will be required from each guest. Acceptable proof of vaccination includes:

- Hard copy of vaccination card
- Photo of vaccination card
- Hawaii State-approved digital/smart device application confirming vaccination status including
 - [Safe Travels Program/Application](#)
 - [Hawai'i SMART Health Card](#)
 - [SMART Health Card Verifier App](#)

Exemptions will be made for the following:

- Individuals who provide proof of negative FDA EUA approved COVID-19 test within 48 hours of visit for patrons (weekly for employees)
- Children under 12 years old
- Individuals remaining 15 minutes or less within a 24-hour period

Whether purchasing tickets online or in-person at the front desk, the Waikiki Aquarium will require proof of vaccination or negative test result upon arrival at the Aquarium. Safety protocols will continue to be in place including but not limited to social distancing between individual parties, mask requirements at all times for guests over 2 years of age and hand sanitizing stations throughout.
